Event Reservation Information

Tugaloo Bend Park is owned and operated by the Stephens County Foundation. Situated on wooded land adjacent to the Chattahoochee National Forest, a hilltop featuring a large meadow is available for weddings and other events, and has a raised platform in place for those purposes. The pavilion sits on a wooded knoll and can be arranged to seat 50 to 60 people theater style on rustic benches. Modern restrooms are nearby. An outdoor kitchen near the pavilion has a twenty-foot serving counter, utility sink and grill.

For weddings, an office and restroom are available for the bride to use prior to the ceremony. All other guests must use the restrooms near the pavilion. For other events, the office and restroom can also be made available upon request.

The property is available to rent for weddings and events. There is a \$250 security deposit for all such rentals. All fees are to be paid in advance. Please visit the Park to determine whether the setting and amenities will suit your needs and plans.

\$500 – Rent the entire Park and amenities during daylight hours. Parking is limited to approximately 100 cars. Exclusive use - Park Closed.

\$200 – Full Day Use of the pavilion and outdoor kitchen during daylight hours. Park is open to the public during regular hours of operation. Maximum of 70 cars parked on site.

\$100 – Half Day Use of the pavilion and outdoor kitchen during daylight hours. Park is open to the public during regular hours of operation. Maximum of 70 cars parked on site.

\$80 – Full Day During daylight hours, use of the pavilion only. Park is open to the public during regular hours of operation. Maximum of 70 cars parked on site.

\$50 – Half Day During daylight hours, use of the pavilion only. Park is open to the public during regular hours of operation. Maximum of 70 cars parked on site.
